...the increase in demand for the  
Whitchurch Foodbank since 2018. For the financial year ending 30 June 2023 34.4  
Tonnes of food was provided to the 2048 persons fed (1291 Adults and 757 Children). 5  
years ago that figure was 1093 (591 Adults and 501 Children) an 87% increase in  
demand.

It costs the Food Bank **£30** to provide enough  
food for a single person and **£78** for a family  
of 4 for a week.
